



Wilderness First Aid April 9th, 10, & 11, 2010

WFA is an American Red Cross 16-20 hour course generally taught over three days.

Designed to help outdoor enthusiast's meet important job prerequisites or anyone who travels or works in situations where help can be delayed.



Who can learn? This program is open to any individual age 15 and older. This is a great course for Camp counselors, Scouts and Outdoor Leaders. Upon successful completion of the course, including a passing score on the final written examination and demonstrated competency in all skill areas, you will be issued a A.R.C. Wilderness First Aid certification. This certification is good for 3 years from your completion date.



What is involved? A.R.C. Wilderness First Aid (WFA) is a 16+ hour class designed to teach the basics of handling emergencies in the backcountry. To adequately prepare students for real situations they may encounter, all courses taught by Wilderness Experiences feature mock emergency scenarios. The instructor will set up the scenario by selecting several students to play the part of patients. These patients will be briefed on their injuries and, in some situations, a little stage makeup will be used to further simulate real injuries. The instructor will then brief the rest of the class (the "rescuers") on the situation and the rescue will begin.



When are the classes? Class will run from **Friday 4pm April 9th until 10pm**. On **Saturday April 10th class will run from 9am to 8pm and On Sunday April 11th class will run from 9am til 4pm**, with a break for lunch. Lunch break usually falls somewhere between 11:30am and 1:30pm. Dinner on Friday and Sat. night will be a group community meal. Lodging can be arranged on site (tenting).



Where do you learn? This class will be held in our newly remolded Outdoor Education Center in Westfield. With Outdoor Scenarios taking place right there.



How Much? Cost: The course fee is **\$125.00** which includes all course materials, certification and all lab fees. Checks are payable to WEU Inc and are non refundable (See policies) Minimum of 8 for the course to run.
